Quiet environment, where you are alone and won't be disturbed



Fast internet connection & accessible backup internet


2. What To Expect

Assessment Battery:

You will complete the following assessments:

1 x Problem Solving Test
1 x Personality Questionnaire

Problem Solving Test



Problem Solving Test Structure:

There are 3 subtests that you will complete:

- 1. Problem Solving **Test 1 = 40 minutes**
- 2. Problem Solving Test 2 = +- 45 minutes
- 3. Problem Solving **Test 3 = 12 minutes**

Total estimated time, including instructions = 2.5 hours

Additional information & Technical Considerations to Note:

Problem Solving Test 1


- This is an analytical task involving 6 drawings, where you have to decide on the correct answer. Only 1 answer is correct.
- All together there are 33 problems to solve, and you will have 40 minutes in which to answer them.
- Some of the problems are challenging. If you are unable to solve a question or answer within the time limit, it is completely normal. Don't spend too much time on a question you find challenging, rather skip it and come back to it if you have time left over.
- When you begin the test, you will be shown how to solve the problems, and you will have 2 examples before you start. Please read the instructions carefully which will explain how to solve the problems.

Problem Solving Test 2:

This tests your ability to learn new skills. There are 3 parts to the test.


Part 1:


- In session 1 you will be tasked to translate symbols into words using a special online dictionary that will appear on your screen.
- Time is short for session 1, so work quickly and accurately. Skip difficult items and rather come back to them if you have time left.
- During the instructions, make sure you can see the **entire dictionary.** You will know that you are seeing the entire dictionary if you can see the **outline of the rectangle** with all the drawings inside.



If you cannot see all aspects, please adjust your Zoom function on your internet browser.

Depending on your browser and computer model, you can do so by following the instructions in these examples:





Part 2:

Here you will be given a lesson, that will teach you more about the dictionary and also give you time to learn it.

Part 3:

Here you will do session 2, which is similar to session 1. You must try to answer more items than in session 1. Therefore, work quickly and accurately, and skip difficult items.

It is extremely unlikely that you will answer all the questions. Don't let that bother you.

Problem Solving Test 3:

This is a straightforward test. Follow the on-screen instructions.

Additional Information



Please ensure to complete all <u>3 subtests within 1 sitting</u> (refer to FAQ's for an explanation of test structure).



Don't spend too much time on a question you might find challenging; rather, skip it and move on.



You will be able to go back and change your answers or answer questions you may have left out, <u>provided</u> you have time remaining.




Visibility: Ensure you can see <u>all aspects of each page for all tests.</u> If you can't, adjust your Zoom function on your internet browser, as explained above.



Navigation: Once you start the problem-solving test, you can navigate between pages by clicking on the green "Next" and "Previous" buttons at the bottom of your page.

Personality Questionnaire



Personality Questionnaire | Important Information:

- Time Management: There is no strict time limit, but aim to complete the questionnaire within <u>45 minutes</u>.
- Honesty: Answer each question truthfully. Do not overthink your responses.
- Authenticity: Provide genuine answers, rather than trying to present yourself in the best light.
- Completion: Ensure you answer all <u>200 questions</u> before submitting. Make sure to click the "submit" button after question 200.



3. FAQ's

1. What is the Recommended Assessment Structure?

As the problem-solving test requires a lot of effort and concentration, you must complete the **problem-solving test first** and then move on to the **personality questionnaire.**

2. Can I Take Breaks?

Yes, you can and must take breaks. We recommend that you follow this structure:

1. Problem Solving Test 1 = 40 minutes

5-minute break (keep test link open)

- 2. Problem Solving Test 2 = approximately 45 minutes
- 3. Problem Solving Test 3 = 12 minutes

10-minute break

4. Start and complete the Personality Questionnaire

How Will I Access the Assessments?

Our team will send you an email containing two links: one for the Problem-Solving Test and another for the personality questionnaire.

If you find that you can't answer within the time limit, or if you're unable to answer a question, it's very normal. Don't let that make you feel nervous or discouraged.

Remember, it's all part of the process of assessing your skills and abilities. Do your best, and don't hesitate to move on if needed.
